

WASHING INSTRUCTIONS

I recommend washing your Woolie about every 6 months as needed. These bags are very dirt resistant, but every once in a while a little trip to the washing machine will keep your bag looking like new.

Here is how you do it:

First, pick off any little balls that may have formed, then take off the flower if you have one and make sure your bag is totally empty. Throw it in any front-loading washing machine in **COLD** water and on a gentle cycle with a small amount of soap. Take it out of the washer and reshape it.

Reshaping:

I like to give the handles a good stretch (they shrink a bit), then pull the bottom corners down, put both your hands inside the bag and give another good stretch (pulling vertically and horizontally), its tough stuff-- don't be afraid to get rough with it! You can really determine the shape of your bag by the way you stretch it. If you want it taller, stretch it by holding the base in one hand and pulling upwards. For a wider purse, stretch it by holding both sides and pulling as you work around the bag. Reshaping should take you less than 5 minutes, but work it as long as you need to get the desired shape.

Then hang it from its handles on a hook or door knob and air dry, allowing between 12 & 24 hours for it to completely dry. If you have any questions, call me at 360.379.3359.
